

<u>ANTC</u> <u>Minimum Basic Agreement Rate Schedule</u>

Rates effective September 1, 2023—June 30, 2024

Fees:

A Theatre's Category shall be established based on the average Gross Weekly Box Office Receipts of all productions presented as part of the season of the Theatre for members and/or subscribers in the previous three (3) year period. (See ANTC Agreement, Schedule A for allowable adjustments.)
