STAGE DIRECTORS AND CHOREOGRAPHERS SOCIETY (SDC) ENDORSES VICE PRESIDENT KAMALA HARRIS AND GOVERNOR TIM WALZ

Today Members of Stage Directors and Choreographers Society (SDC), the theatrical union that unites, empowers, and protects professional stage directors and choreographers throughout the United States, voted overwhelmingly to endorse Vice President Kamala Harris and her running mate, Governor Tim Walz.

Vice President Harris leads a platform that emphasizes critical issues that directly impact the SDC Membership, including workers' rights; arts and culture; access to affordable health care and reproductive rights; gun safety; and voting rights.
